1 MS. ANNA LEE: Good evening. My name is Anna Lee  
2 and I'm an Assistant Director of the Research, Reporting  
3 and Communications Department at the Chicago Housing  
4 Authority.

5 I would like to welcome you all to  
6 the public comment hearing for the proposed Ogden North  
7 Lease and TSP.

8 The purpose of this hearing is to  
9 receive comments on the proposed documents before  
10 presenting them to the Board of Commissioners for  
11 approval and submission to HUD.

12 In addition to voicing your comments  
13 here tonight, residents in the community at large have  
14 the opportunity to submit written comments to CHA during  
15 the comment period which began on May 4th and runs until  
16 June 2nd.

17 Copies of the proposed documents are  
18 available on CHA's website [www.thecha.org](http://www.thecha.org). We've also  
19 brought copies of the documents along with us for onsite  
20 viewing and they are available in the back of the room.

21 If you have not done so already,  
22 please make sure you sign in at the registration table  
23 before you leave tonight.

24 We have a sign language interpreter  
25 here tonight Mr. Dwayne Harris, and he is here in front

1 of the room.

2 Please let us know if you are in need  
3 of interpreting -- sign language interpretation.

4 Thank you, Mr. Harris.

5 We also have a Spanish translator  
6 Antonio Farias who is available to interpret as needed.

7 Please raise your hand, and if you  
8 could also just maybe present your -- introduce  
9 yourself.

10 MR. ANTONIO FARIAS: My name is Antonio Farias.  
11 If you need any interpretation from English to  
12 Spanish --

13 (Spanish translation provided.)

14 MS. ANNA LEE: Thank you.

15 So Mr. Farias will be in the back of  
16 the room if you are in need of Spanish translation.

17 The court reporter will be seated to  
18 the front of the room and will transcribe all that is  
19 said during the hearing.

20 There are various CHA staff here  
21 tonight and available to answer any specific questions  
22 about the public comment hearing.

23 Before we open the floor for  
24 comments, we would like to walk you through an overview  
25 of the new development.

1                   And, actually, that's on this  
2 briefing sheet here. Right?

3                   As we prepare to open the floor for  
4 comments I want to remind each of you that in addition  
5 to having the opportunity to voice your comments here  
6 tonight, written comments are also being accepted  
7 through June 2nd. If you like to only submit a written  
8 comment, please complete the comment card located at the  
9 desk at the back of the room or raise your hand and  
10 staff will bring you one. If you complete a written  
11 comment card, you will not be called to speak.

12                   You may also mail written comments to

16                   If you would like to speak, please  
17 fill out a speaker card located at the front -- or the  
18 back at the desk or raise your hand and staff will bring  
19 you one.

20                   Staff who is assigned to distributing  
21 comment cards, please raise your hands so that the  
22 audience can identify you.

23                   Thanks, Laura.

24                   While the floor is open for comments,  
25 one name will be called at a time. When your name is

1 called, the microphone will be handed to you. Please --  
2 actually, we don't have microphones today. So please be  
3 prepared to comment on the proposed plan.

4 Each person making a comment will  
5 have two minutes to make their comments. Staff will  
6 keep time and let you know when 30 seconds remains and a  
7 bell will ring when your two minutes are over. Once  
8 your two minutes have expired, please prepare for the  
9 next person waiting to make a comment.

10 Speakers may yield their time to  
11 another speaker; however, each speaker may only be  
12 yielded additional time once for a total of four  
13 minutes. If you have a specific question, please speak  
14 to one of the CHA staff here tonight after the hearing  
15 is over.

16 So remember in order for the court  
17 reporter to record all comments accurately, we must  
18 speak one at a time. Please speak slowly and state your  
19 name before the comment.

20 We'll now open the floor for comments  
21 on the TSP and lease.

22 Do we have any comments here tonight?

23 Okay. Well, given that there is no  
24 one here to make comments tonight, I call this meeting  
25 to a close.

1 I would like to thank everyone who  
2 came today for the public hearing. Thanks.
