JENNIFER HOYLE: Good morning. My name is Jennifer Hoyle, and I'm the Director of Strategic Management and Partnerships for the Chicago Housing Authority. I'd like to welcome you to the Public Comment Hearing on the Draft Tenant Selection Plan and Lease for John Pennycuff Memorial Apartments in the Logan Square community.

The purpose of this hearing is to collect comments on the draft TSP and Lease before the documents are submitted to the Board of Commissioners for approval.

In addition to voicing your comment here today, residents and community members can submit written comments to CHA throughout the comment period, which began on July 25th and ends at 5:00 p.m. on August 24th. Copies of the Draft TSP and Lease are available on CHA's website at www.theCHA.org. We also have copies of these documents available here for your review.

If you haven't done so already, please make sure to sign in at the registration table before you leave.

As we begin the meeting, I'm going to make several introductions. First, Kate Sosky is our sign language interpreter, and she is at the front of the room.

Cathy Rajcan is the court reporter; she's seated at the front of the room as well and will transcribe everything that's said during the hearing.

I'd also like to introduce the members of the development team who are here today: Lee Pratter, Senior Director of Development for CHA is seated in the front row; and Greg Stec, from the Metropolitan Housing Development Corporation is seated at the front table.

GREG STEC: John Pennycuff Memorial Apartments at Castillo Plaza is a new construction Transit-Oriented Construction located at 2031-37 North Milwaukee in Chicago, Illinois. The project has 47 CHA units and 41 Low Income Housing Tax Credit Units, Affordable Tax Credits, totaling in all 88 units.

Project consists of studios, one- and two-bedroom apartments. The managing agent is Resident Management Services, Inc. All management documents apply to anyone who chooses to apply to the project.

As far as the breakdown in unit count, we will have 28 studio apartments that will be for LIHTC residents, we'll have 48 total one-bedroom units -- 13 LIHTC and 35 CHA one-bedroom units -- and lastly, we will have 12 two-bedroom CHA units in the proposed new construction development.
