



## Contractor Certification

Under penalty of perjury, the undersigned states that he/she is authorized to execute this Certification on behalf of the contractor and that the contents of the foregoing Certification are true and correct.

On behalf of the contractor, the undersigned hereby certifies and affirms the following:

1. That contractor will comply with the CHA Vaccination Policy and applicable related public health requirements.
2. That, on knowledge and good faith belief, contractor's employees who enter onto any CHA site or who interact with any CHA employee, participant or resident have been [or soon will be] fully vaccinated (defined as fourteen (14) days after receiving the final dose of a two-shot vaccine (Moderna or Pfizer) or a dose of a one-shot vaccine (Johnson & Johnson) against COVID 19, subject to exceptions for any of contractor's employees who have not been vaccinated due to (i) a sincerely held religious belief or (ii) a medical necessity, in which event such employee(s) shall be required to submit to contractor a "negative" COVID-19 test on a weekly basis.
3. That contractor will properly consider its employees' requests for exceptions to CHA's mandatory vaccination requirement and will ensure that any contractor who is granted an exception complies with CHA policy and requirements for testing, masking, social distancing, and any other mitigations that CHA requires or may require.
4. That contractor will maintain and update employee vaccination records, exceptions, and COVID-19 test results in accordance with local, state, and federal law.
5. That contractor has a vaccination policy and procedures, a true and correct copy of which is submitted to CHA with this certification or will be submitted to CHA within 10 business days of the date of this certification.
