New Applications

Who can apply?

Anyone interested in Public Housing and Project Based Voucher program can apply.

Where to apply?

All new applications can be completed online at
applyonline.thecha.org

How to apply?

Follow the on-screen instructions.

You will need your:

- **Social Security Number, Alien Registration Number, or Temporary ID Number (will be assigned)**
- **Date of Birth**
- **Email Address**

You can select the property or property group of your choice.

When to apply?

You can apply at any time. Applications are always open.

What happens next?

You will receive an email confirmation when you have successfully completed your application.

Updating /Checking Application Status

Who can update/check application status?

Anyone who already completed an application for Public Housing or Project Based Voucher program.

Where to update/check application status?

All application updates can be completed online at
applyonline.thecha.org

How to update/check application status?

Follow the on-screen instructions.

You will need your:

- **Social Security Number, Alien Registration Number, or Temporary ID Number (assigned)**
- **Client ID**
- **Email Address**

You can change your selection of a property or property group.

When to update?

You can update/check your application status at any time except if your name has been sent to a property for a housing opportunity.

What happens next?

You will receive an email confirmation when you have successfully updated your application.
